***Economic Development Authority***- No updates.

***Aquatic Invasive Species Program***- North St. Louis County Soil and Water Conservation District provided 2024 inspection results for all the areas serviced by them. Should see results regarding the grant application for 2025 soon.

***Grant Funding Opportunities***- Coldagelli applied to the Eveleth Community Foundation for tennis court crack sealing. The IRRRB Cultural and Recreation Grant will not be open now until July. It was open from January 15<sup>th</sup> to May 1<sup>st</sup>, but the funds have already been expended. Coldagelli is struggling to get quotes for the courts in order to submit the application.
